NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Snohomish County Council will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, March 9, 2022, at the hour of 10:30 a.m. at 3000 Rockefeller Avenue, 8th Floor, Jackson Board Room, Everett, WA, to consider Proposed Ordinance 22-005.

Background: State law requires that the boundaries for council districts be reviewed every 10 years based on the most recent U.S. Census data. New districts should be nearly equal in population and adhere to requirements around compactness, contiguity, not showing favor to political parties or racial groups, following natural boundaries, and preserving communities of related and mutual interest. Snohomish County Charter outlines the process by which council districts be redrawn by an appointed districting committee. The 2021 Districting Committee completed its work and developed a Districting Plan as proposed in the ordinance. A summary of the proposal is as follows:

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 22-005

RELATING TO COUNTY COUNCIL DISTRICTS, ADOPTING A DISTRICTING PLAN AFTER THE 2020 FEDERAL DECENNIAL CENSUS, AMENDING CHAPTER 1.08 SCC, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

The Districting Plan proposes the following Council boundary changes, based on population counts from the 2020 U.S. census:

- District 2: Part of District 2 now extends into District 4. This new portion of District 2 extends southwest from the west side of Silver Lake along I-5 to 164th Street SW. It proceeds east to 3rd Avenue then north along the west boundary of Mill Creek.
- District 4: A small portion of District 4, bounded by Damson Road, S. Danvers Road, and 203 Place SW, has now been moved to District 3.

No geographical changes are proposed to the boundaries of Council District 1 and Council District 5.

The effective date shall be May 2, 2022, provided that the County Assessor, County Auditor, and County Engineer shall take such actions as may be necessary to implement this ordinance on its effective date.

At the hearing, the Council may consider alternatives/amendments to the proposed ordinance.

Background: State law requires council district boundaries be reviewed every 10 years based on the most recent U.S. Census data. New districts should be nearly equal in population and adhere to requirements around compactness, contiguity, not showing favor to political parties or racial groups, following natural boundaries, and preserving communities of related and mutual interest. The 2021 Districting Committee, as appointed pursuant to Snohomish County Charter, developed a Districting Plan outlined in the ordinance. A summary is as follows.
