APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO SIGN AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN SNOHOMISH COUNTY AND THE CITY OF LAKE STEVENS RELATING TO THE OWNERSHIP, FUNDING, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF WYATT PARK

Summary: The ordinance approves Amendment 1 to an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with the City of Lake Stevens (City) to discontinue the use of the County issued Annual Parking and Boat Launch passes at Wyatt Park. In February of 2020, an ILA was executed for the City to accept ownership, management, and the financial responsibility for maintaining and operating Wyatt Park. The City requested to discontinue the use of County issued Annual Parking and Boat Launch passes due to increased costs for its operations. County Parks staff has agreed to make this change and the City will continue to honor County issued Annual Parking and Boat Launch Permits through December 31, 2025. Thereafter, the City will be the sole issuer of any type of parking or boat launch permit for usage at Wyatt Park, beginning January 1, 2026.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
