Consideration:

Motion 22-132 would reappoint Kathleen Santti as a regular member of the Snohomish County Board of Equalization (“The Board”).

Background

The Board typically hears between 1,000 and 1,800 appeals annually to assessed valuation of real and personal property in Snohomish County. As established in Snohomish County Code Chapter 2.76, the Board consists of five regular members and two alternates who serve for terms of three years or until appointment of their successor. No board member may serve more than three consecutive full terms. No more than two regular board members may reside in the same Council district.

Kathleen Santti is an alternate board member residing in District 2. Her current term expires on April 30, 2022. The County Executive recommends reappointing Ms. Santti in a memo dated March 16, 2022. Motion 22-132 would reappoint Kathleen Santti her second full term, beginning May 1, 2022, and expiring April 20, 2025.
