### **Consideration:**

Approving the Port of Edmonds Interlocal Agreement CLFR-035a.

### **Background**

Snohomish County secured Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery (CLFR) grant funds under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). Guidelines for these funds allow the County to transfer funds to a special purpose district of state or local government as a subrecipient. The Port of Everett, a public agency under chapter 39.34 RCW, is authorized to operate rail or motor vehicle transfer and terminal facilities, water transfer and terminal facilities, air transfer and terminal facilities, or any combination of such transfer and terminal facilities, and other commercial transportation, transfer, handling, storage and terminal facilities, and industrial improvements, activities that are important to economic development in Snohomish County.

### **Current Proposal**

The County wishes to provide \$250,000 of CLFR funding to the Port of Edmonds as a subrecipient to support staffing and related benefits of employees performing within the Port of Edmonds to support the Port's public purpose of the operation, maintenance, security, and administration of harbor improvements, such as recreational marina facility, commercial rental properties, and public access owned by the Port.

This ordinance approves the Port of Edmonds Interlocal Agreement, for the period of January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2023, in the amount of \$250,000, and authorizes the County Executive to sign the agreement.
