Approving a proposed annexation to the Lake Stevens Sewer District, BRB FILE 2025-02 - Gosser Sewer Annexation.

Background:

The Lake Stevens Sewer District submitted a Notice of Intention (NOI) to the Boundary Review Board (BRB) for the Gosser Annexation that was filed on May 23, 2025 (File No. 2025-02). The BRB 45-day review period will end on July 7, 2025, at 4:00 p.m. However, per RCW 57.02.040(2), the 30-day review period for County Council to act on the proposed sewer annexation expires June 22, 2025. In the PDS staff report dated June 5, 2025, PDS reviewed the proposed annexation against the requirements of RCW 57.02.040 for water and sewer annexations, the applicable BRB factors and objectives, County codes, and other applicable statutes per SCC 2.77.040. Based on County review, PDS concludes that the Gosser Annexation proposal by the Lake Stevens Sewer District is consistent with the applicable statutory provisions governing special district annexations.
