Subject: Interlocal Agreement with Cross Valley Water District for Information Technology Services

Scope: This is an agreement between Snohomish County and the Cross Valley Water District for network, internet, and GIS support. The agreement allows the city to request services from the mutual agreed upon County Work Order (WO).

Duration: Five (5) year term effective August 11, 2026, through August 10, 2031

Fiscal Impact: Current Year Multi-Year N/A

The total cost of all WOs against this agreement shall not exceed \$60,000 over the term.

Authority Granted: Approves and authorizes the County Executive to execute the Interlocal Agreement for information technology services as well as any associated amendments and work orders between Snohomish County and the Cross Valley Water District.

Background: Since 2020, the Snohomish County Information Technology Department has negotiated with the Cross Valley Water District for use of the County's technology infrastructure and expertise. The proposed agreement includes orthoimagery to the district through the Eagle View/Pictometry Internation Corp agreement. An approved rate model for established contract pricing for any agreed-upon information technology services via Work Orders is included, along with an agreement to share space within the County's data center for cross connections to State, County and other agencies.

The Department of Information Technology will invoice the district annually for the mutually agreed rate model. Revenues are subject to increase based on the purchase of additional services by the District and the approved rate model during the year the work is effective.

Requested Action: For the Council to move to GLS on March 25, 2026, for consideration.
