Subject: ILA to provide IT Services to Tulalip Tribes

Scope: Snohomish County has an existing agreement with Pictometry International/EagleView to obtain Orthoimagery in support of the County's GIS functions. Both the County and the Tulalip Tribes have agreed to share space in the County's data center and to provide the Tulalip Tribes with Orthoimagery services.

Revenues are subject to increase based on the purchase of additional services by the Tulalip Tribes and the approved rate model during the year the work is effective. The agreement not to exceed amount is \$50,000.

Duration: Upon execution for a period of six (6) years. Termination is allowed by either party with ninety (90) days written notice.
