### PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 21-051

## RELATING TO THE 2021 BUDGET; MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN FUND 124 TO PROVIDE EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY FOR RENTAL AND UTILITY ASSISTANCE

Section 1. The County Council makes the following findings of fact: a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$10,628,708.60 is necessary in Human Services Fund 124, for budget year 2021, to provide expenditure authority for rental assistance, utility assistance, administrative expenses, and housing stability services. Direct aid of \$10,628,708.60 provided to Snohomish County from the United State Department of Treasury pursuant to Section 3201 of the American Rescue Plan Act, 2021, Pub. L No.117-2 (March 11, 2021), will fund these services.

<u>Section 2.</u> The appropriation unit and allocation detail for the supplemental appropriation described in Section 1 are as follows:
