WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Historic Preservation Commission was authorized by Amended Ordinance No. 02-007 on April 3, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Commission consists of nine members, recommended by the County Executive and appointed by the County Council; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance requires that there be one member from each Council district and Ms. Hushour's residency in Lake Stevens and Mr. Cruger's residency in Granite Falls meets the requirement for representation from District 5; and

WHEREAS, Jennifer has over 15 years' experience of archeological research and fieldwork in a professional capacity and currently serves as a Cultural Resources Senior Project Manager for a land services company; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Hushour would like to use her knowledge and expertise to serve Snohomish County; and

WHEREAS, Frederick Cruger has served on the board of the Granite Falls Historical Society and the Pilchuck Foundation and has spent a considerable amount of hours creating exhibits and implementing technology into the infrastructure of the Granite Falls Museum; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Cruger has a desire to develop plans and innovative methods for preservation and to encourage techniques that can be leveraged county-wide in particular, a long-term path for creating and maintaining a Historic Asset Inventory;

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the Snohomish County Council hereby confirms the appointment of Ms. Jennifer Hushour, a resident of Lake Stevens in District 5, and Mr. Frederick Cruger, a resident of Granite Falls in District 5 to the Snohomish County Historic Preservation Commission, term to expire in January of 2019.



Mandated Requirements for Appointment:

- The commission shall consist of nine members, at least one from each council district, recommended by the county executive and appointed by the county council pursuant to chapter 2.03 SCC.
- Where possible at least two members shall have professional experience in identifying, evaluating, and protecting historic resources and be selected from among the disciplines of history, architecture, architectural history, historic preservation, planning, cultural anthropology, archaeology, cultural geography, American studies, law or real estate.
- Members shall be residents of Snohomish county except as approved by the county executive and Snohomish county council, PROVIDED that exception to the residency requirement for commission members may be granted in order to obtain representatives from the disciplines of history, architecture, architectural history, historic preservation, planning, cultural anthropology, archaeology, cultural geography, American studies, law or real estate.
- Members of the commission shall have a demonstrated interest and competence in historic preservation and heritage issues and possess qualities of impartiality and broad judgment.
- Members shall be selected without respect to political affiliations.



Fred Cruger spent the first twelve years of his professional life as an officer in the US Air Force, engaged in the design and flight test of advanced weapon systems and inertial navigation systems, finishing his service with three years as an instructor in Electrical Engineering at the USAF Academy. He joined Hewlett-Packard as a Manufacturing Engineer, spent several years as Manufacturing Engineering Manager, and a short time as the Quality Assurance Manager, before becoming the head of Research and Development (R&D) for the division in Lake Stevens, WA. Following fourteen years of being the R&D Manager and Marketing Manager (during which time the division became part of Agilent Technologies, when H-P split into two companies), he joined the Service and Support portion of the company to avoid leaving the Pacific Northwest. He completed 36 years with HP/Agilent, last working from his home in Granite Falls, WA, as a program manager. Much of his time is spent on supporting large aerospace companies in their efforts to service their own high-technology microwave test equipment.

Fred received his BSEE from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, NY, and his MSEE from AF Institute of Technology in Dayton, OH. He graduated with a cum GPA of 4.0, was a member of Tau Beta Pi and Eta Kappa Nu, with biographies appearing in Who's Who in American Colleges and Universities and in Outstanding Young Men of America.

His outside interests are focused on the growth and success of the Granite Falls Historical Society (and Museum), restoring and touring in pre-1916 Automobiles (he owns and operates a number of those), and barbershop quartet singing.

Fred's wife Penny exhibits infinite patience with his projects, is likewise committed to the Granite Falls Historical Society, enjoys touring (in costume, of course) in horseless carriages, and simply smiles when he sings.

RE: Frederick Cruger, Snohomish County Historic Preservation
Commissioner Reappointment

The Historic Preservation Commission was created to advise the county on historic preservation issues and to serve as the Design Review Board for special valuation, a state tax incentive for rehabilitation of historic properties. It surveys and inventories historic resources; nominates properties to local, state and national registers of historic places; reviews proposals to modify historic register structures; and conducts educational programming related to historic preservation and archaeological preservation. The commission is made up of 9 members. There is currently one vacancy.

Frederick Cruger has served on the Historic Preservation Commission for the past three years. He participates in each meeting fully, bringing many suggestions to the board for consideration. It is the intention of Mr. Cruger to share his expertise and experience with the Snohomish County Historic Preservation Commission. His technical skills and preservation knowledge would be an asset to the commission.

Pursuant to SCC 2.03.030, I hereby recommend Council confirmation of Jennifer Hushour to be reappointed to the Snohomish County Historic Preservation Commission for a three year term expiring January 31, 2022.
