COVID-19, a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death, 16 is caused by the SARS-CoV-2 virus, which is a new strain of coronavirus that had not been 17 previously identified in humans and can easily spread from person to person; 18 19 WHEREAS, since January 21, 2020, the disease has spread throughout the United States. 20 On January 31, 2020, the United States Department of Health and Human Services secretary Alex 21 Azar declared a public health emergency for COVID-19, beginning January 27, 2020. On February 29, 2020, Washington State Governor Jay Inslee proclaimed a public health emergency for 22 23 COVID-19. On March 4, 2020, the Snohomish County Health Officer proclaimed a countywide public health emergency for COVID-19. On March 4, 2020, Executive Dave Somers issued a 24 25 "Local Proclamation of Emergency Snohomish County" for COVID-19 (the "Emergency"). On March 13, 2020, the President of the United States of America declared COVID-19 a National 26 27 Emergency; 28 WHEREAS, on December 27, 2020, the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021 (the 29 "Act") was signed into law. The Act included emergency rental assistance established by Section 30 31 501 of Division N of the Act, providing funds for rental and utility assistance to states and units of 32 local government through the Department of Treasury; and 33 WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Commerce has provided such funds to 34 35 Snohomish County for rental and utility assistance. 36 37 BE IT ORDAINED: 38 39 Section 1. The County Council makes the following findings of fact: a supplemental 40 appropriation in the amount of \$33,065,517 is necessary in the Human Services Fund 124, for 41 the budget year 2021, to provide additional expenditure authority for unexpected revenues 42 received from the Washington State Department of Commerce for rental and utility assistance. 43 44 **Section 2.** The appropriation units and allocation details described in Section 1 are as 45 follows:
