Consideration

The Executive’s Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motions 22-241, 22-242, 22-243 and 22-244 which would approve and authorize updates to union agreements, adding Juneteenth as a legal holiday.

Background

SHB 1016¹ was signed by the Washington State Governor on April 20th, establishing June 19th, recognized as Juneteenth, a state legal holiday.

Ordinance 22-023², scheduled for a public hearing on June 15th, amends Snohomish County Code 3A.06 adding Juneteenth as a recognized holiday.

As a result, Human Resources has been working with the collective bargaining units to add Juneteenth to the agreements.
