NOTICE OF ENACTMENT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that on February 8, 2023, the Snohomish County Council adopted Amended Ordinance 22-076, which shall be effective February 18, 2023.

A summary of the ordinance is as follows:

AMENDED ORDINANCE 22-076

INCREASING THE NUMBER OF CONSECUTIVE TERMS A PLANNING COMMISSIONER MAY SERVE FROM TWO TO THREE; AMENDING SECTION 2.08.080 OF SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE

Section 1. Amends SCC 2.08.080 to allow planning commissioners to serve three complete consecutive terms and after at least a two-year absence from the commission, a person may be appointed again to no more than three consecutive terms. It also standardizes capitalization in the section and corrects an error in reference.
