**Background:** The Department of Public Works received federal funding to complete spot safety improvements on the 84<sup>th</sup> Street NE Corridor from SR 9 to SR 92, as this corridor carries a high volume of traffic at high speeds. PH Consulting, LLC responded to RFQ-23-002SB and was selected through established Federal, State and County policies and practices. This included design and implementation of the recommended near-term improvements outlined in the 84th Street NE Corridor implementation Action Plan.
