Summany: The ordinance approves and authorizes the County
Executive to sign the Interlocal Agreement (ILA) for chinook
salmon conservation planning for the watershed planning and
Water Resource Inventory Area (WRIA) 8, in December 2015,
Snohomish County, King County and 28 cities/nowns executed an
ILA to jointly fund and participate in watershed planning and
conservation efforts in WRIA 8. With the conclusion of the current
ILA approaching, a new agreement is currently proposed to
provide continued salmon conservation services. An entity known
as WRIA 8 Salmon Recovery Council will serve as the governing
