

**AMENDMENT 1 TO THE LEGALATOMS CORPORATION LICENSING  
AGREEMENT**

This Amendment 1 to the LegalAtoms Corporation Licensing Agreement (“Amendment 1”), is entered into as of this 3rd day of February, 2020, by and between Snohomish County, a political subdivision of the State of Washington (the "County") and LegalAtoms Corporation, a Washington Corporation with a place of business at 2500 Western Avenue Suite 722 Seattle WA 98121 (Company).

RECITALS

- A. The County and LegalAtoms Corporation are the parties to that certain LegalAtoms Corporation Licensing Agreement (the “Original Agreement”) executed on September 23, 2020; and
- B. The County now desires to continue receiving the software maintenance and support from the Contractor for an additional one (1) year term, under the terms and conditions described in this Amendment 1.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual benefits conferred on both parties, the parties agree the as follows:

- 1. Article 5 of the Original Agreement entitled, Term and Termination, Sub Article 5.1, is amended to add the following:

Term of Agreement. The term of the Agreement is extended and shall continue to December 31, 2021.

- 2. The Order Form is amended to add the following:

Services Fees, Extended Service Term: Shall be \$3,000 per month, payable in advance, subject to the terms of Section 4 herein.

Extended Service Term: Shall be January 1, 2021 – December 31, 2021.

- 3. All other terms and conditions of the Original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect except as expressly modified by this Amendment 1.
