**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE BUDDY BOWL
FOOTBALL GAME**

WHEREAS, the fifth Buddy Bowl will take place on November 17, 2024, starting at 10:00 a.m. at Bob Larson Stadium in Stanwood; and

WHEREAS, the Buddy Bowl is an exhibition football game aimed at increasing public awareness of bullying; and

WHEREAS, in Game 1 – Junior Division, the Arlington Eagles will play against the Stanwood Spartans; and

WHEREAS, in Game 2 – the Midget Division, Sedro-Woolley will play the Stanwood Spartans; and

WHEREAS, according to StopBullying.gov, about 19% of students ages 12-18 in the United States experienced bullying at school; and
