Section 6, Authorizes the Snohomish County.

Section 7, Provides that establishment of County right-of-way is not effective until: (1) the Department of Public Works (7DPW) files a certification with the Clerk of the Council stating administrative and advertising costs are paid; and (2) PDS and DPW has inspected and accepted final construction of the froads; (3) RMH LLC has submitted a two-year maintenance security; and (4) the statutory warranty deed has been recorded.
