### New Start Center Initiative

Capital Construction Projects

- Current Phase
- Includes pre-construction work, renovation on the buildings
- Funded by ARPA, AHBH, fkaARPA (GF)
- Led by Lance Meinhold, Facilities

#### Site Operator Program

- Working on contracts, licensing agreement
- Operators to perform the programs within the building
- Responsible for typical "tenant"-type functions
- Funded by HOME-ARP, AHBH
- Led by Jackie Anderson, HS

### Facilities Maintenance Program

- Will begin when building construction is complete
- Facilities will maintain the buildings
- Responsible for typical "landlord"-type functions
- Funded by AHBH via I/F to Facilities
- Led by Facilities Operations & Maintenance Division

Affordable Housing Behavioral Health (AHBH) Fund supports all these but has a much larger portfolio

### **Capital Construction Project - Progress**

#### **Everett New Start Center**

- Framers, mechanical, plumbing and electrical teams are working through front building as abatement continues in back building.
- Demo and inspection of front walkways completed
  - Damage identified and currently undergoing structural review
  - Had already budgeted for this likelihood
- Because posts have been hit by a car, Facilities will have bollards installed at strategic locations





### **Capital Construction Project - Progress**

#### **Edmonds New Start Center**

- Construction moving forward consistent with timeline.
- Fire suppression system was also impacted by freeze and must be fully replaced.
- Damaged domestic pipe have been repaired.
- Framing, mechanical, plumbing, and electrical are working through the building.
