The Snohomish County Council finds as a fact that a supplemental appropriation in General Fund 002 in the 2021 budget year, in the amount of \$97,047, is necessary to provide expenditure authority for funds received from the Washington State Office of Public Defense for the purpose of providing indigent defense representation for eligible persons seeking to vacate felony convictions and/or to be re-sentenced pursuant to State v. Blake, 481 P 3d 521 (2021).
