10 AMENDING SCC 25.20.050 SERVICE CHARGES FOR AQUATIC PLANT CONTROL -
11 LAKE GOODWIN AND LAKE SHOECRAFT
12

14 WHEREAS, Snohomish County and the property owners around Lake Goodwin and
15 Lake Shoecraft have been working to control Eurasian water milfoil and other invasive
16 aquatic plants; and
17

18 WHEREAS, there is a need to continue the invasive plant control work to protect the
19 beneficial uses of these lakes and to prevent the spread to additional areas in the lakes;
20 and
21

22 WHEREAS, the county council has determined that extending the service charges to
23 control invasive aquatic plants at lakes Goodwin and Shoecraft is in the public interest and
24 will protect the beneficial uses of these lakes; and
25

26 WHEREAS, the Lake Goodwin and Lake Shoecraft volunteer invasive aquatic plant
27 advisory committee held a meeting on February 23, 2024, with county staff to propose new
28 service charge rates for aquatic plant control to fund the milfoil control work; and
29

30 WHEREAS, the county council held a public hearing on October 23, 2024, to hear
31 public comment on the proposed amendment to chapter 25.20 SCC; and
32

33 WHEREAS, the county council concludes that chapter 25.20 SCC should be
34 amended as set forth herein.

36 BE IT ORDAINED:

38 Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 25.20.050, last amended by Amended
39 Ordinance No. 22-042 on November 23, 2022, is amended to read:

41 **25.20.050 Service charges for aquatic plant control – Lake Goodwin and Lake**
42 **Shoecraft.**

43 (1) In addition to the annual service charges established in SCC 25.20.020,
44 each tax parcel abutting the shore of Lake Goodwin or Lake Shoecraft shall
45 be subject to an additional annual water quality restoration service charge for
46 the purpose of managing and controlling invasive aquatic plants.

(2) For the period beginning January 1, ~~((2020))~~2025, and ending December 31, ~~((2024))~~2029, the rate categories and additional annual service charges for real property abutting Lake Goodwin or Lake Shoecraft shall be as follows:

(3) The ~~((single family rate category or the undeveloped rate))~~ lakefront rate category applies to each ~~((lake front))~~ lakefront land parcel classified by the Snohomish County assessor as either single family residential or undeveloped ~~((, respectively))~~. The ~~((community beach))~~ shared lakefront rate category applies to each land parcel having an undivided ownership interest in a ~~((lake front))~~ lakefront parcel used for common beach access. The public and semi-public recreation rate category applies to ~~((lake front))~~ lakefront parcels classified by the Snohomish County assessor as resorts, recreational activities, camping activities, or parks, as well as other publicly owned recreational parcels. ~~((Lake front))~~ Lakefront parcels are defined as land parcels abutting the lake shore.

(4) All service charges collected under this section shall be used solely for management and control of non-native invasive aquatic plants in Lake Goodwin and Lake Shoecraft.

(5) A detailed map of the tax parcels subject to the additional service charges established in this section is available in the department of conservation and natural resources and incorporated herein by this reference.
