NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that on June 14, 2023, the Snohomish County Council approved Ordinance No. 23-045. A summary is as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 23-045

APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO SIGN FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN SNOHOMISH COUNTY AND THE TULALIP TRIBES OF WASHINGTON TO IMPLEMENT PORTIONS OF THE COMMUNITY FLOODPLAIN SOLUTIONS - PHASE II PROJECT

Summary: The County and the Tribes executed an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between Snohomish County and the Tulalip Tribes of Washington to Implement the Community Floodplain Solutions - Phase II Project on October 17, 2022. The ILA required the Tribes provide matching funds to parallel the match required in the Ecology Grant. The County has fulfilled the grant requirement for matching funds, therefore, the Tribes does not need to provide matching funds. The ordinance approves Amendment No. 1 to the ILA to eliminate the Tribes' match requirement.





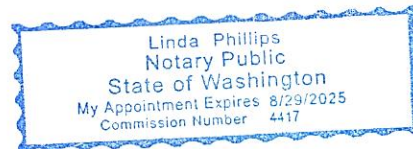
