Background:

Administration of the United States Department of Energy (DoE) Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) program in Washington State is by Commerce. Snohomish County is a subrecipient of funds received by Commerce from DoE for the program. This program delivers weatherization services to provide cost-effective energy efficiency, and health and safety benefits to eligible low-income households. Grant funds provide for local administration and delivery of program services. The original amount of the agreement awarded to Snohomish County was \$311,179; however, DoE has awarded Snohomish County an amended amount of \$735,060 for a new grant total of \$1,046,239. The amended amount was not in the 2024 Grant Work Plan and requires Council approval.

Motion 24-433 would approve a grant contract with Commerce that would provide \$1,046,239 in funding for local administration of WAP BIL program.
