Scope: Appoint the following individuals to the Stillaguamish Flood Control

District Governing Body.

**Background:** Chapter 85.38 RCW outlines the creation and operation of special districts throughout the State of Washington, the Stillaguamish Flood Control District (District) is a special district under this statute. When a vacancy occurs on the governing body for one of these districts, the local legislative authority in which the district resides, either wholly or in majority, is responsible for appointing an individual to fill the vacancy in accordance with RCW 85.38.070(5). In March, the County received official notification of the resignation of two individuals from the District's governing body: Position 1, Rick Williams and Position 2, Chuck Hazelton. The District's governing body has submitted recommendations for appointments to these vacancies and the Surface Water Management Staff has verified that they are qualified voters within the special district.

**<u>Requested Action:</u>** Move to GLS May 21<sup>st</sup> for consideration.
