### **Consideration:**

Motion 22-131 would reappoint Daniel Willner as a regular member of the Snohomish County Board of Equalization (“The Board”).

### **Background**

The Board typically hears between 1,000 and 1,800 appeals annually to assessed valuation of real and personal property in Snohomish County. As established in Snohomish County Code Chapter 2.76, the Board consists of five regular members and two alternates who serve for terms of three years or until appointment of their successor. No board member may serve more than three consecutive full terms. No more than two regular board members may reside in the same Council district.

Daniel Willner is a regular board member residing in District 4. His original appointment was for a partial term that expires on April 30, 2022. The County Executive recommends reappointing Mr. Willner in a memo dated March 16, 2022. Motion 22-131 would reappoint Daniel Willner to his first full term, beginning May 1, 2022, and expiring April 20, 2025.
