1 APPROVED: 2 **EFFECTIVE**: 3 4 5 SNOHOMISH COUNTY COUNCIL 6 Snohomish County, Washington 7 8 ORDINANCE NO. 25-076 9 10 RELATED TO THE 2025 BUDGET: MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION IN 11 THE EVERGREEN STATE FAIRGROUNDS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND OPERATING RESERVE FUND 180 TO AUTHORIZE EXPENDITURE OF PRIOR 12 13 YEAR SURPLUS REVENUES AND ADMISSION TAX REVENUES TO SUPPORT 14 COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE FAIRGROUNDS 15 16 WHEREAS, the determination of the actual operating revenues and admission 17 tax revenues of the Evergreen Fairgrounds (the "Fairgrounds") cannot be made until the 18 closing of the books for the year in which those revenues are received, which closing 19 occurs after the budget for the next-ensuing fiscal year has been adopted; and 20 21 WHEREAS, the actual 2024 operations of the Fairgrounds resulted in revenues 22 that exceeded the operating expenditures for that year; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the actual 2024 admission tax revenues received exceeded the 25 operating transfer of the admission tax revenues for that year; and 26 27 WHEREAS, SCC 4.87.050 requires that surplus operating revenues of the 28 Fairgrounds be placed in Fund 180 for relief of future operating deficits or other 29 Fairgrounds uses determined by the County Council; and 30 31 WHEREAS, the surplus Fairgrounds' operating revenues and admission tax 32 revenues for 2024 have been held in the General Fund 002 awaiting transfer to the 33 Evergreen State Fairgrounds Capital Improvements and Operating Reserve Fund 180; 34 35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED: 36 37 Section 1. The Council makes the following findings of fact: an emergency 38 appropriation in the Evergreen State Fairgrounds Capital Improvements and Operating Reserve Fund 180 for the 2025 budget year in the amount of \$83,791 is necessary to 39 40 provide expenditure authority for surplus operating revenues determined under SCC 41 4.87.050 and admission tax revenues under SCC 4.23.090(2) for funding operating 42 reserves in accordance with SCC 4.87.030 in support of the county fair and fairgrounds. 43 This appropriation is funded by the surplus operating revenues of the Fairgrounds in 44 2024.
