BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

A competitive Invitation to Bid was issued to solicit pricing for the construction of a High Friction Surface Treatment over an existing asphalt or bituminous pavement surface at selected horizontal curves as well as traffic control, pavement markings and other work, all in accordance with the Contract Plans, Contract Provisions and the 2021 WSDOT Standard Specifications.

This project is subject to a DBE goal of 18%.

Funding: Highway Safety Improvement Program and Snohomish County Funds.

RESPONSIBLE BIDDERS:

1. **American Civil Constructors West Coast, LLC** \$ 788,000.00
