- Section 1. Adopts ordinance recitals as findings.
- Section 2. Finding the portion of unopened road right-of-way is useless for County road purposes and the public will benefit by its vacation.
- Section 3. States that the unopened road right-of-way described and depicted in Exhibit A to this ordinance is vacated upon satisfaction of the terms and conditions contained in the ordinance.
- Section 4. Conditioning the vacation upon the Petitioners payment of the itemized costs and expenses under SCC 13.100.070 within one year of the adoption of this ordinance.
- Section 5. Conditioning the vacation upon the Petitioners paying compensation in the amount of fifty percent of the appraised value of the Class B right-of-way to be vacated under SCC 13.100.080 within one year of the adoption of the ordinance.
- Section 6. States that the ordinance shall be recorded and effective upon confirmation that the Petitioners made the required payments and if Petitioners fail to make necessary payments within one year of the adoption of the ordinance it will become void and have no further force or effect.
