Consideration

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 22-351 which would approve and authorize receipt of a supplemental grant from the Washington Auto Theft Prevention Authority.

Background

In 2007 the Washington State Legislature passed HB 10011, making many changes to state law regarding auto theft. Among the many changes, the bill established grants to local government for auto theft prevention and the Washington Auto Theft Prevention Authority (WATPA)² to assist local governments in addressing auto theft.

In 2008 the County received its first grant through WATPA of \$827,185 for the contract period of one year³ and the Snohomish County established the Snohomish County Auto Theft Task Force (SNOCAT). The mission of SNOCAT is to reduce vehicle theft in the County "through pro-active enforcement efforts, apprehension of criminals who steal vehicles, and increasing public awareness of and education about auto theft."4 SNOCAT is comprised of detectives from Marysville Police Department, Snohomish County Sheriff's Office, the Washington State Patrol (WSP), and a prosecutor from the Snohomish County Prosecutor's Office.

Motion 21-390⁵, adopted on December 15, 2021, approved an interlocal agreement for \$1,635,745 for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2023, funding four (4) positions.

Supplemental funds were approved for WATPA in the most recent WA State Legislative Session via Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 56936.

Current Proposal

Scope: Motion 11-351 approves a supplemental grant award from the Washington Auto Theft Prevention Authority for public outreach, training, technology and personnel/professional services.
