Authority Granted: Approve and authorize the County Executive to sign the Public Work Agreement between Snohomish County and Siemens Industry, Inc. for the total not to exceed \$25,000, under SCC 3.04.140(11).

Background: In 2018 the County and Siemens Industry, Inc. first entered into a Technical Services Agreement ([Motion 18-170](#)) to upgrade and standardize the County's card access systems in various County facilities. Since then, additional facilities, security expansions and contract extensions have been added via amendments, with the most recent Amendment 19 in September 2023 ([Motion 23-388](#)).

Due to an oversight, the recent BOMARC and DJJC facility work failed to be included in the previous amendments. Facilities is seeking expedited Council authorization for the Executive to sign the Public Work Agreement for the security work that has been completed within these facilities and Security Support Specialist hardware.
