Capital Construction Projects

- Current Phase

- Led by Lance Meinhold, Facilities

Site Operator Program

- Just starting working on contracts, licensing agreement (Fac)
- Operators to perform the programs within the building
- Responsible for typical "tenant"-type functions
- Funded by HOME-ARP, AHBH
- Led by Jackie Anderson, HS


Facilities Maintenance Program

- Will begin when building construction is complete
- Facilities will maintain the buildings
- Responsible for typical "landlord"-type functions
- Funded by AHBH via I/F to Facilities
- Led by Facilities Operations & Maintenance Division


Affordable Housing Behavioral Health (AHBH) Fund supports all these but has a much larger portfolio

- All work to ready the buildings for construction has been completed.
- Permits have been submitted for both buildings. We are awaiting approval. Timeline 2-8 weeks.
 - While we hope this is the final review cycle, there could be additional comments.
- General Contractors and subcontractors now have access to the buildings and are assessing current conditions.
- General Contractors are ready to mobilize as soon as they receive a Notice to Proceed.


- The Salvation Army (TSA) approved
