#### **Urban Tree Canopy**

#### Baseline

 Continue existing regulations and monitoring reports

- Consider Council-Initiated Amendments
  - New policies
  - Changes in regulations
  - New programs for urban forest management
- Impacts for capacity estimates for land use alternatives







#### Ag Preservation

#### **Baseline**

 Continue implementation of existing policies to preserve and expand farm industry

- Consider new policies for preventing conversion of ag land, and expanding markets and related support industries
- Extensive outreach to farmers and rural residents






#### Open Space

#### **Baseline**

- Review and amend existing policies and implementation based on updated CPPs, including policy support for Regional Open Space Conservation Plan
- Updates to Parks and Recreation Element
- Consider designating Open Space/Preserve classified parks as necessary to support development

#### Possible Discretionary Addition

 Implement Regional Open Space Conservation Plan concurrently with 2024 update instead of phasing it after update





#### Broadband

#### <u>Baseline</u>

- Review existing policies for consistency with updates to GMA and CPPs
- Updates to Capital Facilities Element related to telecommunications providers

- Broaden policy support for increasing access to broadband internet outside of the urban area and other underserved communities
- Coordinate and incentivize extension of broadband to support economic development
- Extensive outreach to community and to service providers



#### Hazard Mitigation

#### **Baseline**

- Update Capital Facilities Element to incorporate 2020 Hazard Mitigation Plan
- Review policies for consistency with updated plan

#### Possible Discretionary Addition

 Implement objectives in 2020 Hazard Mitigation Plan through policies in other elements of the Comprehensive Plan, and develop implementing regulations concurrent with 2024 Update rather than phasing after the update



#### Resilience

#### Baseline

- Update climate change policies consistent with updated CPPs
- Update Capital Facilities Element to incorporate 2020 Hazard Mitigation Plan

- Consider amendments focused on resilient communities and resilient economy
- Extensive public outreach to communities, businesses, service providers



#### Rural/Urban Edges

#### **Baseline**

 Continue existing policies and review for consistency with updated CPPs

- Consider policy amendments to enhance policy direction for the edge areas of Rural and Urban Areas
  - Greenbelt Buffers
  - Working open space
- Extensive public outreach to property owners in vicinity of existing or proposed Urban Growth Area Boundaries
