AMENDED MOTION NO. 24-300

APPOINTING CITIZENS TO THE PRO AND CON COMMITTEES  
FOR A BALLOT MEASURE AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE NO. 24-047,  
SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE COUNTY  
A PROPOSITION AUTHORIZING A LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX OF TWO TENTHS OF  
ONE PERCENT FOR PUBLIC SAFETY, HEALTH, AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the County Council adopted Ordinance 24-047 on July 10, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 24-047 approved a ballot proposition be submitted to the qualified voters of the county pursuant to RCW 82.14.450 to authorize the imposition of a local sales and use tax of two tenths of one percent to provide funds to be used for public safety, health, and criminal justice purposes; and

WHEREAS, funds shall be used in accordance with new Chapter 4.140 SCC as adopted in Section 4 of Ordinance 24-047; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 29A.32.280, for each measure from a unit of local government that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voters' approval of the measure and shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voters' rejection of the measure; and

WHEREAS, the county issued a press release and posted a notice on the County's website and social media notifying the public that citizens can apply to serve on the pro or con committee; and

WHEREAS, the County received two (2) applications for the pro and four (4) applications for the con committee and each committee shall have no more than three (3) members;

NOW, THEREFORE ON MOTION, the Snohomish County Council appoints:


- (1) Trudy Dana and Kameon Quillen to serve on the Pro Committee; and
- (2) Billye Brooks-Sebastiani, James D Kellett, and Kurt Hanke to serve on the Con Committee
