Subject: Approving amendment no. 1 to agreement with Lake Stevens Food Bank Association.

Scope: Snohomish County and Lake Stevens Food Bank Association entered into a contract in August of 2022 for grant funds in the amount of \$600,000 on a reimbursement basis to construct Phase 1 of building that will house food bank distribution for the public; a truck bay and receiving area for food shipments, and food preparation spaces. This amendment increases the not to exceed amount to \$850,000, an increase of \$250,000 to cover change orders, landscaping, inspections, etc.

Duration: Execution through twenty years from final payment or usability of facility.
