Mukilteo Water and Wastewater District, a special purpose municipal corporation, has applied to Snohomish County, Washington, for a non-exclusive franchise to construct, maintain, operate, replace and repair water distribution and wastewater conveyance systems in, on, across, over, along, under, and/or through public rights-of-way within the following portions of unincorporated Snohomish County:

If approved, proposed Ordinance No. 23-063 would grant said franchise to Mukilteo Water and Wastewater District, subject to all of the terms and conditions contained in the ordinance.

If approved, the franchise would go into effect following enactment of the ordinance, acceptance by Mukilteo Water and Wastewater District, provision of evidence of insurance, and payment of all applicable fees. The maximum term of the franchise would be twenty (20) years from the effective date.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.


