CALL TO ORDER

Council Chair Dunn called the Council to order at 10:30 a.m.

ROLL CALL

The clerk called the roll and stated that four members were present.

ACTION ITEMS

1. Ordinance 22-034, related to the 2022 Budget; making a supplemental appropriation in General Fund 002 from funds received from the Administrative Office of the Courts to provide expenditure authority for District Court's Mental Health Court [2022-0821](#)

Council Chair Dunn opened the public hearing and the clerk read the ordinance title into the record.

Heidi Beazizo, Sr. Legislative Analyst, provided a staff report, and explained that this ordinance requests supplemental appropriation related to grant funds to provide expenditure authority for costs related to two ftes to serve the Mental Health Court. She said there is no impact to the General Fund and no match required.

Council Chair Dunn opened the hearing for public testimony and provided instructions for those wishing to provide testimony for both in-person and remote, via Zoom. There being no persons present wishing to testify, Chair Dunn closed the testimony portion of the hearing calling for a motion or discussion of the Council.

ACTION: Vice-Chair Mead made a motion to approve Ordinance 22-034. Councilmember Low seconded the motion. The clerk called the roll and the motion to approve Ordinance 22-034 carried unanimously by the four members present.
