PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 21-103

APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY
EXECUTIVE TO SIGN ADDENDUM TO INTERLOCAL
AGREEMENT FOR THE WATERSHED BASINS WITHIN WRIA 8

WHEREAS, the county and city governments of Snohomish and King counties (the "parties"), lying wholly or partially within the management area of Watershed Resource Inventory Area ("WRIA") 8, which includes all or portions of the Lake Washington-Cedar, Sammamish, and Central Puget Sound watersheds, share mutual interests in addressing long-term watershed planning and conservation for the watershed basins therein; and

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2015, the Snohomish County Council ("County Council") passed Ordinance No. 15-087 authorizing the Snohomish County Executive ("County Executive") to execute the Interlocal Agreement for the Watershed Basins within Water Resource Inventory Area 8 ("WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement") for the period 2016 through 2025; and

WHEREAS, on October 31, 2018, Snohomish County withdrew its participation in the WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement due to lack of funding; and

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2020, Snohomish County signed Amendment No. 1 to reinstate its participation in the WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Everett wishes to participate in the WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement requires unanimous written consent of all parties to the City's request to join the Agreement as a voting member of the WRIA 8 Salmon Recovery Council; and

WHEREAS, the WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement further requires that all written amendments, alterations or clarifications be approved by the party's legislative body; and

WHEREAS, the addendum to the WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A is authorized by the Interlocal Cooperation Act, chapter 39.34 RCW; and

WHEREAS, the County Council held a public hearing on _____, 20____, to consider approving and authorizing the County Executive to sign the addendum to the WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement attached as Exhibit A to this ordinance on the County's behalf;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. The County Council hereby adopts the foregoing recitals as findings of fact and conclusions as if set forth in full herein.

Section 2. The County Council approves and authorizes the County Executive to execute the Addendum to Interlocal Agreement for the Watershed Basins within Water Resource Inventory Area 8 ("WRIA 8") in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 3. The County Council further authorizes the County Executive to execute any future addenda to the WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement for the sole purpose of allowing jurisdictions to become members of the WRIA 8 Salmon Recovery Council so long as such jurisdictions are identified as eligible to become members under that agreement.

At the hearing, Council may consider alternatives/amendments to the proposed ordinance.

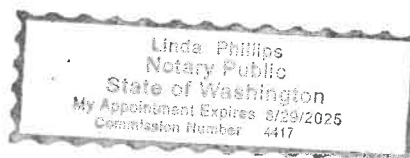

APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO SIGN ADDENDUM TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR THE WATERSHED BASINS WITHIN WRIA 8

WHEREAS, the county and city governments of Snohomish and King counties (the "parties"), lying wholly or partially within the management area of Watershed Resource Inventory Area ("WRIA") 8, which includes all or portions of the Lake Washington-Cedar, Sammamish, and Central Puget Sound watersheds, share mutual interests in addressing long-term watershed planning and conservation for the watershed basins therein; and

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2015, the Snohomish County Council ("County Council") passed Ordinance No. 15-087 authorizing the Snohomish County Executive ("County Executive") to execute the Interlocal Agreement for the Watershed Basins within Water Resource Inventory Area 8 ("WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement") for the period 2016 through 2025; and

WHEREAS, on October 31, 2018, Snohomish County withdrew its participation in the WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement due to lack of funding; and

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2020, Snohomish County signed Amendment No. 1 to reinstate its participation in the WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Everett wishes to participate in the WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement requires unanimous written consent of all parties to the City's request to join the Agreement as a voting member of the WRIA 8 Salmon Recovery Council; and

WHEREAS, the WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement further requires that all written amendments, alterations or clarifications be approved by the party's legislative body; and

WHEREAS, the addendum to the WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A is authorized by the Interlocal Cooperation Act, chapter 39.34 RCW; and

WHEREAS, the County Council held a public hearing on February 2, 2022, to consider approving and authorizing the County Executive to sign the addendum to the WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement attached as Exhibit A to this ordinance on the County's behalf;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED:
