APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 16 TO CONSOLIDATED CONTRACT WITH WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND PROVIDING AUTHORITY FOR FUTURE AMENDMENTS REGARDING COVID-19 LHJ GAP FUNDING, EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF RESILIENCY & HEALTH SECURITY – WFD LHJ, OFFICE OF IMMUNIZATION – FSU UKRAINIAN COMMUNITY OUTREACH RESOURCE CENTER, OFFICE OF IMMUNIZATION – UKRAINIAN OUTREACH SUPPORT

<u>Summary:</u> The ordinance approves Amendment 16 to the Consolidated Contract with the Washington State Department of Health (DOH) to continue providing core public health services. The Health Department receives the majority of its grant funding through a consolidated contract with the Washington State Department of Health. This funding is used for many different public health services including maternal and child health block grant, recreational shellfish activities, tuberculosis control, and many more. Amendment #16 increases funding by \$3,519,641 for a total consideration of \$35,178,552; and amends and adds statements of work for multiple programs.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
