WHEREAS, this Affordable Housing and Behavioral Health Capital Fund Interlocal Agreement will establish use of the Technical Advisory Committee and Policy Advisory Board to advise the County Executive and County Council on the planning, administration, and expenditure of funds from the taxes in chapters 4.122 and 4.126 Snohomish County Code; and
WHEREAS, Chapter 39.34 RCW, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, authorizes public agencies, including the County and the cities and towns within Snohomish County, to enter into cooperative agreements with one another to make the most efficient use of their respective resources; and
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:
Section 1. The Snohomish County Council approves the Affordable Housing and Behavioral Health Capital Fund Interlocal Agreement and authorizes the County Executive to sign the Agreement.
