Authority Granted: Authorizes the Executive to execute Amendment #10 to the Software Licenses Agreement with Jury Systems Incorporated.

Background: The County has been using Jury Systems Incorporated (formerly Unicorn) to provide jury management services to the Snohomish County Superior and District Court since 1990. The software used through Jury+ has been upgraded over the years as their services have expanded. JSI now offers a service called JURY+ Web Generation which provides a web based communications module for use between. The Clerk's Office wishes to expand the system to include this new module.
