GRANTING A NONEXCLUSIVE CABLE FRANCHISE AUTHORIZING LIMITED USE OF THE PUBLIC ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY IN SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON TO ZIPLY FIBER NORTHWEST, LLC D/B/A ZIPLY FIBER

Ziply Fiber Northwest, LLC D/B/A Ziply Fiber has applied to Snohomish County, Washington, for a non-exclusive franchise to construct, maintain, operate, replace and repair a telecommunications network in, on, across, over, along, under, and/or through public rights-of-way within unincorporated Snohomish County.

If approved, proposed Ordinance No. 24-034 would grant said franchise to Ziply Fiber Northwest, LLC D/B/A Ziply Fiber, subject to all of the terms and conditions contained in the ordinance.
