Consideration

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 21-397 approves and authorizes Amendment 2 to the Public Defender's Association (PDA) LEAD Contract.

Background

In June 2020, the Council passed Motion 20-212¹ approving a \$1.69 million grant award from the Washington State Health Care Authority (HCA) to implement a Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion (LEAD) program² from June 9, 2020 through June 30, 2021. The county entered into an agreement with the PDA on August 16, 2021 to reimburse for LEAD Project Management Expenses; the original agreement was approved by Motion 21-266.³ The term of the original agreement ended September 30, 2021 and was extended to October 31, 2021 by Amendment No. 1.

Current Proposal

Scope: Motion 21-397 approves Amendment. No. 2 extending the term an additional year and increasing the annual reimbursement amount available by \$10,000 (from \$140,000 per year to \$150,000). All other terms and conditions remain the same.

Duration: 10/1/2021 - 9/30/2022

Fiscal Implications: Not to exceed \$150,000
