WHEREAS, in Game 3 - the Midget Division; the Stanwood Spartan White will face off against the Stanwood Spartan Red; and


WHEREAS, according to StopBullying.gov, about 20% of students age 12-19 in the United States experienced bullying at school; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Buddy Bowl is to bring the community together to oppose bullying; and


WHEREAS, following the football game, speakers will give inspirational messages about the importance of opposing bullying; and
