

Summary: The ordinance amends the Solid Waste Advisory Committee (SWAC) composition to include representation from commercial Organics firms in Snohomish County. The amendment adds two new member positions representing commercial organics firms—one voting and one non-voting—to ensure that organics management is formally integrated into the committee's structure. This addition provides industry expertise in composting, food waste reduction, and other organics-related operations, supporting compliance with state organics diversion mandates and advancing sustainable solid waste strategies that reduce landfill dependence and greenhouse gas emissions.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.


