Background: The [Snohomish County Community Services Advisory Council](#) (CSAC), [Chapter 2.420 County Code](#), was established in 1986 through Ordinance 86-076. The purpose of CSAC is to advise the Executive and Council through the Department of Human Services on matters pertaining to the cause of poverty and reduction in the effects of poverty (SCC 2.420.010). Since its creation, the CSAC code has not been amended. The Executive's office has indicated that they have been unable to maintain the minimum number of members on this board and through a state monitoring report it was recommended that the minimum membership be reduced.
