Subject: ARPA – Inmate Transport Vehicle Purchase

Scope: Approve a contract with TriVan Truck Body, LLC for the purchase of a customized inmate transport vehicle. In accordance with the agreement, the vehicle will provide separate seating areas with separate air flow systems to allow for up to 20 inmates and four (4) deputies with the intent of reducing and/or preventing the potential spread of COVID19.

Duration: Execution through December 31, 2024

Fiscal Impact: Current Year Future-Year N/A

\$78,293 will be paid to the contractor up front, and the remaining \$234,879 will be paid upon completion/delivery of the vehicle.

Authority Granted: Authorizes the Executive to execute the contract.

Background: On March 11, 2021 H.R. 1319 was signed into law, American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). This bill included \$65.1 billion in direct aid to counties for Coronavirus recovery efforts with Snohomish County slated to receive around \$160 million¹. These funds may be used for costs incurred beginning March 3, 2021 through December 31, 2024.²

Requested Action: Move to GLS on November 29th for consideration.
