Consideration:

Authorize the Executive to execute Interlocal Agreements disbursing the 2022 Flood Damage Reduction Grant Program funds.

Background:

The 2022 budget included \$150,000 in Surface Water Managements budget for the Flood Damage Reduction Grant Program. SWM solicited applications from Diking and Drainage Districts within Snohomish County and received two applications/proposals. The purpose of this grant is to provide funding for improvements that help protect County road systems from flooding.

Current Proposal:

Scope: Authorize the Executive to execute two Interlocal Agreements, awarding grant funding to the Ebey Island/Diking Improvement District No. 1 and Stillaguamish Flood Control District. Available grant funds would be split equally between the two Districts (\$75,000/each) and provided on a reimbursement basis pursuant to the ILA and Exhibit A of this ordinance.

Duration: Execution through December 31, 2023

Fiscal Implications: \$150,000 – Allocated in 2022 budget.
