### PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 24-012

APPROVING GRANT AGREEMENT WITH DARRINGTON SCHOOL DISTRICT TO SUPPORT PREVENTION OF AND TREATMENT FOR SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS

<u>Summary:</u> The ordinance approves a grant agreement to provide funds to Darrington School District as a subrecipient under the Health Resources Services Administration (HRSA) Rural Communities Opioid Response Program (RCORP) to support prevention or treatment for substance use disorders. The funds will be used to hire a term-limited behavioral health specialist to provide training to staff on evidence-based strategies to help with children's self-regulation and reinforce pro-social behavior. The grant is not to exceed \$155,000.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
