### Subject:

Mobile Vaccination Site License Agreement between Snohomish County and Mukilteo School District

### Scope:

The Health Department is seeking to enter into an agreement with the Mukilteo School District to use three schools as sites for operation of mobile vaccination clinic. The sites are Explorer Middle School, Mariner High School, and Voyager Middle School.

Under the agreement, an entity will grant the County a 50 square foot location at each of their properties for mobile vaccination sites. The sites are authorized to provide childhood, flu, and COVID vaccinations and events, dates, times, and other details shall be agreed to by both the County and the entity.

Motion 25-057 authorizes the Executive to signs the mobile vaccination site license agreement with Mukilteo School District.

### Background:

On September 6, 2023, the Snohomish County Council passed Ordinance 23-075<sup>1</sup> approving form agreements for use of school sites to provide mobile vaccination clinic services. The ordinance authorized approval of future agreements by motion.

Prior to its integration into the County, the Snohomish Health District held agreements with various entities to allow access to property for operating Mobile Vaccination Sites for the purpose of serving underserved communities. With the integration into the County, new agreements must be executed.
