**Summary:** The ordinance approves an agreement with Health Care Authority to support Medicaid related outreach and linkage activities performed by Local Health Jurisdictions to residents who live within its jurisdiction. These activities assist residents who have no or inadequate medical coverage, and includes explaining the benefits of the Medicaid program, assisting them in the Medicaid application and renewal processes, and linking them to Medicaid covered services. This Agreement provides a process for partially reimbursing the Health Department for allowable and reasonable expenses associated with the time its staff spend performing Medicaid Administrative Claiming (MAC) activities

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
