### **Background**

Snohomish County Council appropriated funding for Council projects as part of the 2022 Adopted Budget, further amended by Ordinance 22-001. To address the unprecedented isolation created by the pandemic, the City of Monroe has chosen a playground in a QCT in the local community to upgrade with new equipment including ADA accessible play areas.

The proposed Interlocal Agreement, which is for a one-year term through December 31, 2024, sets the terms by which the County will reimburse the City of Monroe for eligible expenses for the project, up to a maximum of \$100,000.

To approve and authorize the County Executive, or designee, to sign the Interlocal Agreement between Snohomish County and the City of Monroe for Blueberry Hill Children's Park Improvements.
